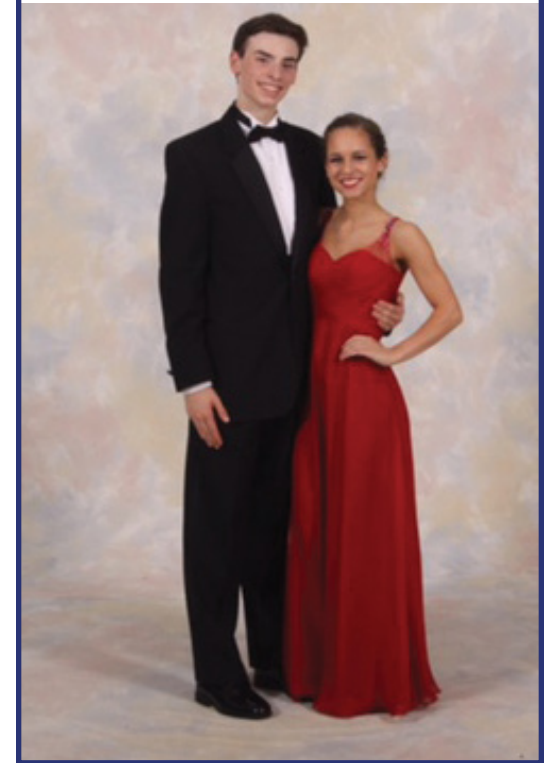

Jill Wollins is always happy and proud to be teaching for Dance Masters of America. She grew up in Chapter 8, and remembers the best years of her life dancing at DMA conventions and competitions. Prior to TTS and SHIP being held at the University at Buffalo, Jill received her collegiate dance education at the Center for the Arts. She received further dance training at Duke University, American Dance Festival, and held scholarships at Steps NYC and Giordano School in Chicago. Jill started her performing career at Disney Orlando, and continued onto NYC to be a Radio City Rockette on and off for ten years. During the time she wasn't a Rockette, she toured nationally with "The Producers," "Will Roger's Follies," and "Grease".

Movie/TV credits include The Producers, Disney's Christmas Special, Fox Morning Show, numerous appearances on David Letterman, and of course Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade. Her favorite credits include dancing at Lincoln Center with Chita Rivera and at the Kennedy Center of Performing Arts. She is also extremely excited to announce her latest book, "Dance: Are You Ready for the Next Step," available on Amazon. This book prepares young dancers for the next steps in their dance careers beyond high school including finding the right college, getting into the professional world, auditions, agents, and potential earnings. It also includes interviews of several professionals from City Ballet to Broadway to Bieber dancers, and their views on being successful in the industry, while maintaining a balanced life.

Chris King

Chris King is a NYC based performer who has traveled and toured to over 35 countries. Tours include: Bad Boys of Dance, Movin Out, and the Radio City Rockettes. He has also worked on numerous commercials and TV/film including both seasons of Smash on NBC. Recently Chris finished up a three year run as Chistry in Wicked on Broadway and is currently teaching across the country. Anthony Russo

Anthony Russo landed his first professional gig at 15 in the 18 plus Equity Ensemble of "Anything Goes". At 17 he was hired for the 6th National Tour of "Tap Dogs" and went on to perform all 6 roles in the show throughout North America, Europe, South Africa, Saudi Arabia, Taiwan, Australia, and China. Between tours with Tap Dogs, Russo has been involved in the creation and performance of Cirque Du Soleil's "Banana Shpeel" in Chicago and NYC. Recently, Russo performed a tap duo act in the #1 show in Las Vegas, "Absinthe". In January 2017, he performed alongside his brother in a guitar/tap dance duo act, "The Russo Brothers" at the Palm Cabaret in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. In 2005, Anthony produced his first tap intensive, "TAPademics", and continues to host the workshop at his family's dance studio in St. Charles, MO. Anthony is co-founder and Director of the touring in-house tap workshop, "TapThe Map". His teaching/judging experience also includes, Jump, Nuvo, DMA, and DEA. In 2013 Russo was awarded Outstanding Young Missourian by The Missouri Jr. Chamber of Commerce for his contributions to dance education nationwide. His touring company, "Tap The Map", received acknowledgement from The Missouri House of Representatives for facilitating over \$75,000 in scholarships to students around the US and Canada. Anthony is currently based in Las Vega, NV.
