After receiving her BA in Dance from Muhlenberg College, Angelina Young Savage toured the world with Sesame Street Live as a dancer, singer, understudy and director. She returned to Pittsburgh as the assistant director of Czarniak Tap, and a dancer/rehearsal director of Continuum Dance Theater. Off the stage in Pittsburgh, Angelina taught at numerous studios and performing arts academies including the Lincoln Park Performing Arts Charter High School and Millennium Dance Complex, as well as other facilities throughout the East Coast. Now a resident of Las Vegas, Angelina has been seen tap dancing in local industrials and musicals. She also judges and teaches for a number of dance competitions and conventions. Angelina is the founder and director of Resonance Tap Experience and producer of the Rock City (Cleveland), and Steel City (Pittsburgh) Tap Fests and director of in-studio tap intensives around the country. Away from dance Angelina is the Events and Entertainments Manager of BEST Agencies. She has five rescue dogs and one very supportive (former dancer) husband.

*Tricia Sundbeck-Bell*

Born and raised in Stockton, California, Tricia Sundbeck-Bell became a ballet student before entering grade school. She apprenticed with the Sacramento Ballet Company throughout her high school years. While training with Sacramento Ballet, she enhanced her experience by attending summer workshops with San Francisco Ballet. She also was awarded a scholarship to Boston Ballet School during this period. Ms Sundbeck has had the great privilege to dance many of the principal roles of the great classical ballets during her 20-year professional career, including Juliet in Romeo and Juliet, Marie in the Nutcracker, Aurora in Sleeping Beauty, Swanilda in Coppelia, and the title roles in Giselle, Swan Lake, Cinderella, A Midsummer Nights Dream, La Fille Mal Garde, and Beauty and the Beast. During her long career, Ms Sunbeck has had the distinction of working with such notable stars as Frederic Franklin, Allegra Kent and Suzanne Farrell. Her career has taken her around the world, which has included performing in notable venues and in the company of distinguished dignitaries. She has had the pleasure of performing throughout the US, Canada, Portugal, Amsterdam, and Germany. She is currently teaching, choreographing, and coaching throughout the US. In 2018, she began teaching for the University of Cincinnati College- Conservatory of Music Dance Department. Since moving to Ohio she also has had the opportunity to be involved in DMA. She has taught, judged, and coached for the Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Bluegrass Chapters.

Alicia is from Charlotte, NC where she trained in ballet, tap, jazz and modern. She is an Ailey/Fordham BFA graduate currently in her 5th season at Hubbard Street Dance Chicago.
