# **ODM Charity Outreach Guidelines**

### Eligibility:

Any student of a participating ODM Member in good standing.

### Applications:

Dancers or their Teacher may submit a letter that outlines the dancers' needs and current health situation.

# Deadline:

Applications MUST be received by the ODM Board NO LATER than August 1<sup>st</sup>. Applicants whom are not chosen for the current year will automatically be considered by the Board Members for the following year.

# **Chosen Applicant's Duties:**

- 1. Name the charity and choose the color for the bracelets.
- 2. **Closed Convention FALL** : introduce yourself to our Board Members/Grand Body either in person OR via zoom.
- **3.** November PAC/Open Scholarship: you will be given the opportunity to speak and/or perform during the PAC weekend. You may also elect to have someone speak on your behalf.
- **4.** WINTER Title Competition: you will be given the opportunity to speak and/or perform during the PAC weekend (you may also elect to have someone speak on your behalf); at each level of the title competition (Petite/Master, Junior, Teen, Miss/Mr.).
- 5. March PAC/Open Scholarship in Cleveland: you will be given the opportunity to speak and/or perform during the PAC weekend. You may also elect to have someone speak on your behalf.

#### **Monies Collected:**

- 1. Money will be collected for the Charity Outreach throughout the year as donations or for purchasing one of the Charity Outreach Bracelets.
- 2. All money collected from the March PAC "Dress Down" will be applied to the charity.
- **3.** All money collected will be turned in to the Chapter Treasurer at the end of each convention.
- **4.** The recipient of the ODM Charity Outreach will receive 75% of all money collected; the remaining 25% will be sent directly to a charity of the applicant's choosing which directly correlates to the charity representative.
- 5. All monies will be mailed out during the summer.
