



~Ohio Dance Masters Charity Drive~

Hello and thank you for having me. My name is Alli Hile, I am 18 years old and I have Cystic Fibrosis. I would like to tell you about my life with CF.

Cystic fibrosis is a progressive, genetic disease that causes persistent lung infections and limits the ability to breathe over time. There is no cure.

When we were born I had to stay in the hospital for 116 days. I had 2 surgeries before I was even 3 weeks old. When I was in 2nd grade I became very sick and had to have a portion on my lung removed. Overall, I've had 6 surgeries, visit the doctor monthly, take about 30 pills a day and do 3 hours of respiratory therapy daily. But this is just part of my story. I am also a dancer with the Marjorie Jones Competition Team dancing around 15 hours weekly, an aspiring school and dance teacher, a twin sister, friend, daughter, niece and so much more.

Today, I am doing great. December 18 marked 5 years since I've had a hospital admission. However, in the past 3 months everything changed. In November, I wasn't at my best and did not compete at our last ODM convention in Dayton. Soon after that I had the opportunity to participate in a clinical trial for a new medication. It was a blind study, but I knew very quickly that something was different. CF causes a direct impact to my lung function. Without getting into a bunch of science, let's just say we are all born with healthy lungs functioning at 100%. As time went on my lung function decreased because that's what CF does to lungs. 2 months ago, my lungs were functioning at 61% and dropping. After participating in this trial, my lung function climbed to 94%. Not to mention the persistent and annoying cough has literally just stopped. I have more energy in school and dance. Life looks different for me these days. Clinical trials, new medications and more effective treatments are a direct outcome of fundraising. So basically, I am a living and literally BREATHING example of what the funds you donate this weekend will do to benefit people with CF.

I couldn't be happier to be competing this weekend. Dancing is everything to me. Exercising my lungs helps them stay strong. But, dance has not only provided exercise for my lungs, it has given me my very best friends. They support me and make me laugh and never ever make me feel different. They see me as Alli, not the girl who has CF.

I'm proud to share that I have committed to the University of Dayton majoring in Elementary Education, and I plan to minor in Dance. I hope to teach dance and one day be right back here with my own students as a member of Ohio Dance Masters.

I want to thank Ohio Dance Masters and all my Junior member friends for being so supportive and for selecting CF as your charity for this season. I couldn't be more thankful for this opportunity to educate people about CF and how it affects my life. The funds raised will allow for vital research leading to new and better medications and treatment like what I have shared with you today.
